Windows page size

features menu

hold down the CTRL key and at the same time scroll your mouse to increase or decrease the viewed page to the size you like .

Choose Settings, you can change the system setup
In Windows 10 it is called Ease of Use
In Windows 11 it is called Accessibility

it offers Appearance for font and text size and Accessibility for extensions via web store
